

Proceeding of 143rd Management Committee Meeting
Held at CSIR-CLRI, 8th February, 2020, 4:00 pm

The meeting was presided over by President Dr P. K. Seth, and a total of 24 members from 11 Centres representatives who were present. He informed that some of the members have passed away during 2019. Two minutes silence was observed in their memory. The meeting was adjourned and reconvened.

Dr Seth welcomed all the members and said that CPWA is actively perusing the health care issues concerning its members. He apprised about the recent meeting of CPWA officials with DG, CSIR on 19th January, 2019 at Lucknow and said that DG has kindly agreed in principle and said that one CSIR one medical card is a good idea and assured that he will see it is done at the earliest. The issue of reimbursement of expenses on drugs incurred in emergency was also raised and he assured for the same. We expect a resolution shortly. A written request for these including a dispensary at Palampur, provision of Ayurvedic consultants was submitted to DG.

Dr J. K. Johri, General Secretary presented the minutes of 142nd meeting held on 4th January, 2020 which were approved by voice vote. Dr Johri, further informed that the election results for new Management Committee will be announced at GB tomorrow by Dr Purohit the electoral officer.

Individual Centres raised their issue. The Bengaluru and Mumbai Centre stated that they have not been allotted space in the campus for office premises as in case of Chandigarh, Jamshedpur etc.. They were informed that this matter may be perused with Director as has been done in some centers.

Dr P. K. Awasthi, Secretary, CSIO Chandigarh extended invitation for holding the 29th AGBM 2021 at Chandigarh, which was accepted by GB.
